



Curry College presents: Experiential Learning 1 Credit Course

This 1-credit Experiential Learning course at Curry College leverages the Beyond Akeela camp experience as a dynamic learning laboratory, fostering essential career and life skills through a structured, hands-on approach grounded in Kolb's Experiential Learning Theory (ELT).



Taught by Curry College faculty, students will actively engage in concrete experiences within the camp setting, reflective observations through guided facilitation and move toward abstract conceptualization, connecting their experiences to broader academic concepts. Students will then engage in active experimentation, applying their newfound knowledge and insights to future scenarios including creating action plans for post-secondary education and employment, practicing communication strategies, and simulating workplace interactions.

By cycling through these stages of ELT, this course empowers students to not only gain practical workplace competencies but also to cultivate a lifelong learning mindset, building confidence in navigating their future academic and career paths.
